Don Knight is a retired partner in King & Spalding's Atlanta office, he was a member of the Corporate Practice Group. In addition to domestic mergers and acquisitions, his practice included advising non-U.S. investors (including non-U.S. governments, companies and high net worth individuals) with respect to structuring, negotiating and effecting investments of various kinds throughout the United States. Such investments have included corporate acquisitions, venture capital investments, real estate investments and complex securities portfolios. Mr. Knight is the author of numerous papers and articles on matters of international law and taxation and frequently speaks at professional seminars held in the United States and abroad. *Chambers USA* recently selected Mr. Knight as a leading lawyer in his practice area.

Mr. Knight graduated with highest honors from Mississippi State University in 1961. He received a masters degree in Comparative Literature from Emory University in 1963 and received his J.D. from the University of Virginia Law School in 1967.
