**Gene Pfeifer** is a retired partner in the Washington, D.C., office where he was a member of the firm's FDA & Life Sciences Practice Group. He joined King & Spalding as a partner in 1986.

He served for a year in the General Counsel's office of the Federal Trade Commission and ten years in the Chief Counsel's Office at FDA as Associate Chief Counsel for Enforcement, Associate Chief Counsel for Drugs and Deputy Chief Counsel for Regulations and Hearings. During his ten years at FDA, he was the agency's premier litigator; with one exception, he briefed all of the FDA's cases before the Supreme Court in the 1970s.

Mr. Pfeifer was a major participant in the development of the Drug Price Competition and Patent Term Restoration Act of 1984. As a leading authority on the subject, he provides strategic counseling to companies affected by that statute. In addition, Mr. Pfeifer and his colleagues provide regulatory advice and representation on a wide variety of drug approval, advertising, promotion and compliance issues. Resolution of these issues may and often does require appearances before FDA, DEA, FTC, CMS and federal courts.

Mr. Pfeifer is a graduate of Brown University and the Georgetown University Law Center (1967).
